

MARINE VIEW PARK
20945 Marine View Drive SW

Type, Location and Description

This park, located in an environmentally sensitive area, is the City's only park that provides access to a salt-water beach.

The park, consisting of 27.37 acres of heavily wooded bluffs and ravines, is located between Marine View Drive and Puget Sound, south of 208th Street. The upper portion, adjacent to Marine View Drive, is level and presently, has gravel paths through the woods. The rest of the wooded portion of the property is a steep bluff and large ravine. Locations



along the edge of this bluff provide an excellent view of Puget Sound. The beach is a combination of gravel and sand with a very gentle slope. The upper beach, between the base of the bluff and the high tide line, is quite narrow and may be fully covered by water in extreme high tides.



Improvements include a paved emergency access road and trail to connect the upper portion of the park with the wooden tower at the end of the road. The wooden tower has a walkway that provides access to the beach. Other improvements include a gravel parking lot, other trails, interpretive signs and other facilities.

Facility and Equipment

Beach access tower, one portable toilet, four benches, two picnic tables, a paved walking trail, and a few primitive "adventure" trails.

Principle Recreational Uses

Walking, picnicking, and beachcombing.
