REMOVAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Flammable and combustible liquids shall be removed from tank and connected piping.
2. Piping at tank openings which will not be used further shall be disconnected.
3. Piping shall be removed from ground. (Exception: Piping may be abandoned in place when Inspector determines that removal is not practical. Abandoned piping shall be capped or safeguarded as required by Inspector.)
4. Tank openings shall be capped or plugged, leaving 1/8" to 1/4" diameter opening for pressure equalization.
5. Tanks shall be purged of vapor and inerted prior to removal.
6. Tanks shall be disposed of in accordance with Federal, State,

ABANDONMENT IN-PLACE REQUIREMENTS:

1. Flammable and combustible liquids shall be Removed from tank and connected piping.
 2. Suction, inlet, gage, vapor return, and vapor lines shall be disconnected.
 3. Tank shall be filled completely with inert material approved by the Inspector.*
 4. Remaining underground piping shall be capped or plugged.
 5. Site plan, record of tank size, and date of abandonment shall be submitted to the City.
- * NOTE: If using slurry mix, the following proportions shall be used: 1yd. sand,

and City regulations.*

1.5 sacks Portland Cement, 47 gals. water,
24oz air entraining agent, 18oz wetting
agent.
