

CITY HALL PARK
801 SW 174TH STREET

Type, Location and Description

This 7.85-acre park is an active-use park. The park attracts users from surrounding communities who enjoy the park's high quality baseball and soccer fields. The site was purchased from the Highline School District in 1987. The south building was remodeled and is now used as City Hall. The north building is used as the Normandy Park Recreation Center.



Facility and Equipment

Improvements include two outside basketball courts, a fenced children's play area dedicated in May 2012, a handicap accessible restroom outbuilding, benches, tables and playfields that can be configured into three baseball/softball fields or two soccer fields. It also includes a paved walking trail that meets the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility standards.
